- Establishing appropriate town planning scheme and zones
- Creating of sustainable human settlement environments for greenfields and upgrade





Lessons for Exploration and Piloting

Likely to have 3 Pilot Sites (Greenfield; Upgrade new and old) :to demonstrate some key lessons from Sao Paulo:

- Social and Environmental Spaces: to invest in order to link communities, and neighbourhoods and to share opportunities and assets
- Clustering of social facilities in nodes and corridors
- "Social Workers " and facilitation to be deepened to improve community involvement, design, effectiveness and ownership
- Address integration across sectors (social, economic, environmental, housing, transport, architecture and urban design and development management) neighbourhood and a project level.
- Focus on simple, cost effective, details at design level: painting, storm water management, landscape design for improvement of the overall environment and experience.
- Funding allocation to include support for: architectural-urbanism, place making skills, social investment, environmental management, community involvement and empowerment in projects
- Data collection and information to support decision making, design with a particular focus on social data and enhancement on Prioritization Models
